in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Four hundred Fifty (\$450.00) Dollars, to be paid on or before the date when the 29th Series of the Installment

Beginning at a point on the Laurens Road, joint corner of lots no. 21 and 22, running thence with line of lot no. 22, S. of 34.19 W. 175 feet; thence S. 55.41 E. 50 feet; thence N. 24.19 E. 195 feet to Laurens Road; thence with the Laurens Road, N. 55.41 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning.
