computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,

bargain, sell and release unto the said B.F. Scott: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, designated as part of Lots No. 12 and 13, property known as Melville C. Westervelt, Trustee, said plat having been recorded in Plat Book "F" at page 23.

Beginning at an iron pin north side of West Augusta Drive, at a point 225 feet from North-east corner of West Augusta Drive and Paris Road, running thence N. 20.16 E. one hundred sixty feet to an iron pin on line of lot No. 6, which pin is Two hundred twenty-five feet from the eastern side of Paris Road; thence with line of lots No. 5 and 6, S. 55.15 E. sixty-two and one-half feet to an iron pin on line lot No. 5; thence S. 20.16 W. one hundred sixty feet to an iron pin on north side of West Augusta Drive; thence with the northern side of West Augusta Drive, N. 55.15 W. sixty-two and one-half feet to the point of beginning.
