All that ~~lot~~ or parcel of land situate on the west side of ~~the~~ Munnings Street in Ward 5, in the City of Greenville, County and state aforesaid and known as lot number Fourteen on a plat recorded on page 604 Vol. 28.8 in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and having the following angles and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a point on Munnings Street, fifty-two feet from Dunbar Street; thence with Munnings Street North 18 East fifty-two feet to a stake; thence north 76 West Two hundred four feet along line of lot no. 13 to a stake on a ten foot alley; thence with line of said alley, South 18 West fifty-two feet to a stake thence south 76 East two hundred four feet to the beginning corner.
