interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and to enforce this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or)  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said R.O. Henry

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said T.H. Jones: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,  
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Chick Springs Township and having the  
following metes and bounds to wit:- Beginning at a corner on the old National Highway and  
runs North to a corner; thence West to a corner; thence South with line of Lynn McConnell  
land to a corner; thence East to Old National Highway; thence with said Highway East to the  
beginning corner and containing 25 acres, more or less. Bounded by lands of Robert Miller,  
Lynn McConnell, T.H. Jones, Mrs. Flynn and the Old National Highway, and being the same land  
conveyed to me this day by T.H. Jones.
