aforesaid and being lots numbers Seven and Eight fronting on a road extending from the G.S. & A.
railroad to Piney Road and known as Piney Mountain Park Lot #7 fronting on G.S. & A. railroad
to Piney Road 116 feet and extending back along the right-of-way of the G.S. & A. railroad
740 feet to a corner; thence extending along the line of lot #8 to the road 687 feet.
Lot #8 beginning at a stake 160 feet above the G. S. & A. railroad line on road leading from
