WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Ola Young Henry*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*Woodside National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina*  
in the full and just sum of *Two hundred and fifty (\$250.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *Ninety (90) days from date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *quarterly*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or)  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I* the said *Ola Young Henry*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Woodside*  
*National Bank of Greenville South Carolina*  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said

*Ola Young Henry*  
in hand well and truly paid by the said *Woodside National*  
*Bank of Greenville South Carolina*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Woodside National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, all that*

piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in City and County of Greenville, State  
of South Carolina, being a portion of the Rowley Place and having the following metes and  
bounds, to-wit: Commencing at an iron stake northeast corner of Lavinia Avenue and a 10-foot  
Alley, and running thence in an easterly direction along said alley one hundred and forty five  
(145) feet to a stake; thence in a northerly direction to a stake on a 10-foot alley; thence  
along said alley Forty three (43) feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 24 and 25;  
thence in a Southwesternly direction along joint lines of the said lots one hundred and fifty  
five (155) feet to an iron pin on Lavinia Avenue; thence S. 21-45 E. along said Lavinia Avenue  
fifty-five (55) feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed  
to me by J.D. Woodside by his deed dated 2nd, day of February 1920 and recorded in R.M.C. Office  
for Greenville County in Vol. 69 at page 14, this being known as Lot No. 24 in survey of said  
Rowley Place by W.A. Adams Jan. 1910. There are no other mortgages, liens or encumbrances on  
the above described lot of land.
