That I, *Annie Barton* of *Greenville County, South Carolina* SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Annie Barton*  
in and by *my* certain *Provisionary* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *and* well and truly indebted to

*Louise Earle*  
in the full and just sum of *Six Hundred and no/100 (\$600.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *in five (5) equal annual installments of*  
*One Hundred Twenty (120.00) Dollars each.*

with interest thereon, from *Date* at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*Five per cent (10%)* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Louise Earle, her heirs and assigns*

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, County and State aforesaid,  
about six miles from Greenville Court House, just off the White Horse Road, containing  
8.40 acres, more or less, and known as Tract No. 6 on plat of property of Charlie P.-  
Rogers, Estate, survey made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, January 11th, 1923, and having the  
following courses and distances according to said plat: Beginning at a stake, corner of  
tract No. 5 and running thence with line of said tract S. 72 E. 4.61 to stone, corner  
of tract No. 7; thence with line of said tract N. 35 E. 16.59 to stake; thence N. 51 W.
