WHEREAS, I, the said Charles Meyer  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

J.C. Milford  
in the full and just sum of Three (\$300.00)  
Dollars, to be paid on the 3rd day of January, 1924

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi-annually  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, of said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage) as in and by the said note.  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said J.C. Milford:

All that certain  
lot, piece or parcel of land situated lying  
and being in the county and state  
aforesaid near Meland Cemetery, having  
the following metes and bounds to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Gillespie  
street and running along said street fifty  
(50) feet to an iron pin on Campbell street;  
Thence along said Campbell street seventy  
six feet, ten inches (76-10) to a stake, thence  
leading said Campbell street and running  
along same separating this property and  
property of Peter White Eighty feet and three  
inches (80-3) to a stake; thence ninety eight  
feet and seven inches (98-7) to an iron pin  
the beginning corner, and being the same  
piece of land purchased by me from
