Dollars, to be paid *\$ 511.66 January 10, 1922*
\$ 511.66 January 10, 1923
\$ 511.67 January 10, 1924

with interest thereon, from *13th day of August 1920* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note *to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,*
who may sue thereon and enforce the same, together with the cost of collection, for an attorney's fee of *10%*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount *of* *November 10, 1926* to be collectible as a debt, and if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or)
any part thereof, be collected by *legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note*
reference being thereunto had, as *more fully appear.*

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *E. L. Burry*
in consideration of the *sum of money* said, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said
Parker Land Co.

according to the terms of said note *me*, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Parker Land Company*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Parker Land Company. That certain lot or parcel of land situate*
in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, known as Tract # 83, on Plat 2 of the
Parker Land Co., surveyed by A.S. Bedell, April 1924, and more particularly bounded and
described as follows:

Beginning on a stone below a wild cherry tree, the northwest corner of tract #79, runs
thence with the line of tract #79, W. 81 degrees East 10.45 chains to the northeast corner
of tract #79, in the center of Parker Road. The said corner being in the West line of tract
88; thence up the center of Parker Road with the West line of tract #88, the following
courses and distances N. 11 degrees E. 3.03 chains; N. 22-1/4 degrees E. 4.20 chains; N. 12-1/2
degrees E. 6.00 chains to a stake in the Southeast corner of tract #83-1/2 thence with the
line of tract #83-1/2 E. 69 degree W. 16.80 chains to an iron pin, the corner of tract #83-1/2,
87, 82 and 78; thence with the line of tract #78, S. 16-3/4 degrees E. 8.63 chains to the
