

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, Flora Williams

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Flora Williams in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the date of 2nd day of October 1924

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Three Hundred Fifty and 20/100 (\$350.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 2nd day of October A. D. 1924, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Flora Williams shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of October 1924, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Five + 83/100 (\$5.83)

Dollars, (\$3.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Three and two-hundredths Shares of Stock, and Two + 33/100 (\$2.33)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five + 37/100 (\$5.37) Dollars, (\$3.50)

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One + 87/100 (\$1.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Four + 90/100 (\$4.90) Dollars, (\$3.50)

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One + 40/100 (\$1.40) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Four + 43/100 (\$4.43)

Dollars, (\$3.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Ninety-three cents (\$0.93)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Three + 97/100 (\$3.97) Dollars, (\$3.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Twenty-seven cents (\$0.27)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 3 1/2

shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by Flora Williams to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon or charged against the said Flora Williams

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Flora Williams in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,

according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Flora Williams

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the City of Greenville granting Nichols street 40 feet and returning back on parallel lines to lot of Elisha Lydia Nesbitt (same lot described in a deed to James Williams, dated February 1918 recorded in Book 82, page 412 K.M.C. office for said Greenville, South Carolina.
