That, J. P. Haswell of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, J. P. Haswell, the said, in and by J. P. Haswell, certain note or obligation, bearing the 10th day of October, 1924, indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Five Hundred Fifty (\$550.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 10th day of October, A. Nine & 17/100 (\$9.17) Dollars, ( \$5.50 ) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Five Hundred (\$500) Shares of Stock, and Three & 67/100 (\$3.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Eight & 17/100 (\$8.17) Dollars, ( \$5.50 ) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & 93/100 (\$4.93) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of

Seven & 40/100 (\$7.40) Dollars, ( \$5.50 ) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & 20/100 (\$4.20) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of

One & 47/100 (\$1.47) Dollars, ( \$5.50 ) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Six & 23/100 (\$6.23) Dollars, ( \$5.50 ) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Six & 23/100 (\$6.23) Dollars, ( \$5.50 ) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Seven & 7/100 (\$7.07) Dollars, ( \$5.50 ) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said

Haswell the said in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to

Haswell in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In Greenville, South Carolina, being lot No. 17 of South Cherokee Park, according to a plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 130 said lot fronts Keowee Avenue sixty (60) feet and runs back a depth of One hundred Seventy-two (172) feet to an alley in the rear, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Cherokee Land Company by deed dated May 15th, 1907 and recorded in Volume 4, 44, Page 2 R. M. C. office for Greenville County.
