

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, F. W. Williams  
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:  
WHEREAS, I, F. W. Williams, the said F. W. Williams  
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the 13th day of July 1925  
indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,  
duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of One Thousand five hundred fifty Dollars, (1550.00)  
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 13th day of July A. D. 1925,  
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that  
I, the said F. W. Williams shall pay or cause to be paid to the said  
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of July  
1925, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty five  
and 83/100 (25.83) Dollars, (15.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the 15 1/2 Shares of Stock, and 10.33  
Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the  
sum of Twenty three and 77/100 (23.77) Dollars, (15.50  
Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 8.27 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);  
for the next twenty months the sum of Twenty one and 79/100 (21.79) Dollars, (15.50  
Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 6.20  
Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Nineteen and 63/100 (19.63)  
Dollars, (15.50 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 4.13 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seventeen and 57/100 (17.57) Dollars, (15.50 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 2.07 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)  
Each of the above payments shall be made on the 20th or before the 1st day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 15 1/2  
shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid shall be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said  
F. W. Williams  
and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon or charged against me, the said F. W. Williams  
in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the  
said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.  
NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said F. W. Williams  
in consideration of the debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,  
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me  
the said F. W. Williams  
in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and  
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Near the Judson Mills and Carley Bridge  
Road, shown as lot No. 5 on plat of property  
of N. H. Harris, made by R. C. Dalton, recorded  
in Plot Book C, page 257, said lot having a  
frontage of 82.8 feet on the east side of  
Georgia Ave, with a depth in parallel  
lines of approximately 180 feet to right  
of way of the P. & N. Railroad.
