

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, Ellison G. Glenn

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, Ellison G. Glenn, the said Ellison G. Glenn, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the 15th day of October 1926

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Fifteen hundred & no/100 (\$1500.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 15th day of October A. D. 1926,

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I the said Ellison G. Glenn shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of November 1926,

and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of \$25.00 Dollars, (\$1500) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Fifteen (15) Shares of Stock, and \$10.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$23.00 Dollars, (\$1500) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$8.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of \$21.00 Dollars, (\$1500) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$6.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$19.00 Dollars, (\$1500) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$4.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$17.00 Dollars, (\$1500) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$2.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Fifteen (15) shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid shares to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made I, the said Ellison G. Glenn,

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon or charged against I, the said Ellison G. Glenn,

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the conditions hereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Ellison G. Glenn, the said Ellison G. Glenn, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Ellison G. Glenn,

in hand well and truly paid to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the County of Greenville, in ward six on Grove Street, and bounded and designated as lots nos. 8 and 21 as shown on Plat made by W. A. Hudson, March 21st, 1908, and recorded in the C. M. C. office in and for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", at Page 225.

Beginning at an iron Pin on the south side of Grove Street, and running thence in an Easterly direction fifty (50) feet with Grove Street to an iron Pin; thence in a southerly direction two hundred (200) feet to Spring Street; thence with said alley in a westerly direction fifty (50) feet to an iron Pin; thence in a northerly direction two hundred (200) feet to an iron Pin, the beginning Point, being the same lots of land conveyed to me by D. B. Staley, by deed dated October 4th, 1926, to be recorded.
