Fields, [unclear] 21 feet to an iron pipe, thence with same property S 44 35 E 60 feet to an iron pin on west side of Parker Street, thence along west side of Parker Street N 47-30 E 21 feet to the point of beginning said lot of land surveyed November 1922 by R.
