

Agreement for Extension of Loan No. 79051
 whereas, there remains unpaid on a certain note
 executed and delivered by Janie E. Furman to
 The Prudential Insurance Company of America,
 secured by a mortgage upon real estate Greenville
 County South Carolina dated December 16th, 1926
 and recorded in said County on December 29, 1926
 in Volume 123 of Mortgages on Page 202, the
 sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) with interest
 from December 16th 1926 and,
 whereas, title to the mortgaged premises is now
 vested in Janie E. Furman subject to said
 mortgage, and,
 whereas, the said Insurance Company has been
 requested to make said note payable as hereinafter
 agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration
 of the payments to be made as herein provided.
 Now, Therefore, the said Janie E. Furman hereby
 agrees to pay the principal sum remaining due
 as aforesaid as follows:

Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars on December 16th, 1931
 with interest thereon from December 16th 1926 to
 December 16th 1931, at the rate of five and one
 half per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually
 and with interest after maturity as set forth
 in said note.

Prepayment Privilege:

Privilege is given to make payments of \$100.00
 or any multiple thereof on the principal sum
 of said note at any interest payment date.

And, the parties to this agreement hereby con-
 sent to said extension and agree that said
 mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said
 premises, and that said note and mortgage,
 and all their covenants and conditions shall
 remain in force except as herein modified.
