SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *J. W. Reid*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*The Norwood National Bank*  
in the full and just sum of *Five hundred (\$500.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *on or before September 14, 1925*

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *semi-annually in arrears*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*ten per cent (10%)* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said *The Norwood National Bank, its*  
*successors and assigns,*

*All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the city and county of Greenville State aforesaid and being in Ward 2 and being more particularly described in a plat of "Boyer's Addition" recorded in R. M. C. office plat Book "A" page 90 and 91 and having the following meter and bounds, to-wit:  
Commencing at an iron pin on Williams street, corner of lot now owned by Mrs. Hattie Culbertson and running thence N. 15-1 W. along Williams street 50 feet to an iron pin on a 15 foot alley; thence N. 65-0 E. 150 feet along said alley to an iron pin; thence S. 15-1 E. 62 feet to an iron pin; thence along lines of Mrs. Hattie Culbertson's lot in a southwesterly direction to a pin, the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by T.
