with interest thereon, from **March 10, 1925** at the rate of **7** per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid **annually**

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
