SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I* the said *mortgagor* hereinabove named

even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to *The*  
*mortgagee* hereinafter named *J. W. Norwood*  
in the full and just sum of *Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *on or before one year after date*

with interest thereon, from *This date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *semi-annually in advance*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*Ten per cent of debt thereon* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *mortgagee*  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said *mortgagor*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. W. Norwood and his heirs and*

*assigns all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina and county of Greenville in Austin Township on branch waters of Gilders Creek, waters of Croree River on the Laureus Road, about seven miles south-east of the city of Greenville having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stake or brass and running thence N. 46° W. 14.08 chains to a stake; thence N. 50 1/4° W. 9.98 chains to a stake; thence S. 79 1/2° W. 2.25 chains to a stake on Laureus Road; thence with said road S. 58° W. 58.50 chains to a stake; thence S. 73° W. 9.45 chains to the beginning corner; thence S. 64 7/8° E. 4.20 chains to a stone; thence S. 42 1/3° W. 1.50 chains to a stone; thence S. 73° W. 9.45 chains to the beginning corner; and thence and one half (1 1/2) chains more or less, and being the same as the tract of land in said mortgage, to wit: This being a first mortgage on said land, and being given for the purchase money thereof.*
