WHEREAS, *al* the said *W. D. Norman*
in and by *my* certain *Promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *um* well and truly indebted to *The Bank of*
Commerce, a Corporation under the laws of the State
of South Carolina *One Thousand*
Dollars, to be paid *\$500.00 on June 13th 1925 and \$500.00 on July*
13th 1925

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or

who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
sell and release unto the said *The Bank of Commerce its successors and assigns*

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, near Sterling Annex, described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of an unnamed Street in line of lands of Sterling Annex, and running thence along the line of unnamed Street S. 51-46 E. 65 feet to an iron pin; thence northeast 133 feet, more or less, to Emma Williams line; thence along said line N. 51-28 W. thirty nine feet, more or less to line of Sterling Annex; thence along Sterling Annex line S. 49-44 W. one hundred and thirty five feet to the beginning corner, being Lot No. 9 and a part of lot No. 8 of a subdivision of land represented on a plat of record in Plat Book "C", page 92 in the office of the R.M.C.
