SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Mrs. H. K. Belwood  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to H. P.  
McGee and C. M. McGee as Trustees.  
in the full and just sum of Four thousand & no/100 (\$4,000.00)  
Dollars, to be paid One (1) year after date.

with interest thereon, from the date hereof at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid quarterly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten Percent (10%)  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Mrs. H. K. Belwood  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said H. P. McGee  
and C. M. McGee, as Trustees,  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Mrs.  
H. K. Belwood in hand well and truly paid by the said H. P. McGee and C. M.  
McGee, as Trustees.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said H. P. McGee and C. M. McGee, as Trustees,  
their successors and assigns, all those tracts of land  
in Greenville Township, South Carolina, about  
five miles from Greenville County Court House  
on Saluda River as follows:-

Fifty-four (54) acres, more or less, on Bush  
Creek and said Saluda River, being that tract  
conveyed to me by W. L. Barroway deed dated April  
4th, 1921, and recorded in Volume 70, Page 522,  
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Also Ten and one-half (10 1/2) Acres on Casley Bridge  
Road joining lands of Mrs. A. J. Rison and  
others being the same conveyed to me  
by A. J. Floyd deed dated January 19th, 1923,  
recorded in Volume 78 page 466, R. M. C. Office  
for Greenville County, South Carolina.

North side of Casley Bridge Road and on  
Saluda River being the land conveyed to
