1896 and being a part of the property of the estate
of Malinda Chapman, said tract of land, having the
following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a
stone known at the southeast corner of said tract
no. 5 and running thence N. 12 West 18.50 chs. to a
stone, thence South 83 W. 24.33 chs. to a stone 34 m;
thence South 5 West 16 chs. to a stone, thence North 33
East 28 chs. to the point of beginning; said tract of
land being bounded (in 1896) on the South by lot no.
4, on the East by Charles Cason, and on the
