Marion Hazelhurst Gordon* its successors and assigns, all of that certain piece of land or lot of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and in Greenville Township and being part of lot number twenty-nine (29) of the Duck Brook subdivisions according to Survey and plat made by J. S. Clin Jones, September 1913 and of record in office of R. M. H. for Greenville County, South Carolina in plat books & page 251-252. The above described lot being more particularly described as follows to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the northern line of Belmont Street, corner of lots #29 and #30 (above mentioned, plat) and running thence a long Belmont Street S. 36-32 W. 55.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 32-44 W. 111 feet to an iron pin in center of ten (10) foot alley, thence along said alley N. 33-10 E. 6 feet to an iron pin on Southeast corner of said alley; thence along the eastern line of said alley N. 32-44 W. 10 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 33-10 E. 50.8 feet to an iron pin on line of #30, thence S. 32-14 E. 130 feet to the beginning point.
