interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent on the
amount due on said note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Lot #20 of Phoree Annex, a part of the Sterling College property conveyed to L.O. Patterson
by E. Inman, Master by deed recorded in Volume #40 at page 66, in R.M.C. Office for
said County, and this lot has the following metes and bounds: Beginning on Maloy Street
at the joint corners of lots #20 and #21 and running thence with line of lot #21, S.
55-35 E. 134.1 feet; thence N. 15-15 E. 53.2 feet to joint corners of lots #19 and #20;
thence with line of lot #19 N. 60-20 W. 120.8 feet to Maloy Street; thence with the said
