with interest thereon, from *date* *15th day of April* (at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to be added to the principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to be immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for attorney's fee of *ten per cent*
