with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and note further providing for an attorney's fee of

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto made, as and more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Chas. T. Turner
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Chas. T. Turner
in hand well and truly paid by the said Susie H. Glover

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Susie H. Glover: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville
on the West side of Toy Street, having the following metes and bounds: Commencing at an iron
pin on Toy Street and a fifteen foot alley, and running thence S. 65 W. along said alley 101
to an iron pin, corner of lot formerly owned by R.G. McPherson; thence S. 15 E. along line of
said lot 55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65 E. 101 feet to an iron pin on Toy Street; thence
with Toy Street 55 feet to the beginning, being part lots numbers nine and nine and one-half
of Block seven as shown on plat of Boyce Addition, recorded in Plat Book "A", page 179.
Also the strip adjoining the above, conveyed to Walter S. Griffin by John Robbins White, by
deed dated Jan. 13, 1920 said deed recorded in Volume 58, page 213, and having the following
boundaries as described in said deed: Beginning at a point on Toy Street 140 feet from my
property line of Pettigru Street, where it intersects with Toy Street, and running thence S.
65 W. 101 feet; thence N. 15 W. 5 feet, more or less, to the line of the lot owned by White;
thence N. 65 E. along that line 101 feet to a point on Toy Street; thence along Toy Street S.
15 E. 5 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
Being the same lots of land conveyed to me by Walter S. Griffin by deed dated March 31st, 1922
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 73, page 554.
