All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known as a portion of of the property of Paris Mountain, Caesar's Head Development Company, lying on the Northeast side of Alta Mount Road as shown on plat of Paris Mountain Caesar's Head Land Company, prepared by R.
