The said H. J. Hayesworth subsequently conveyed his one-half interest in the same to W. J. Shackton, by deed dated July 14, 1906, recorded in said Office in Vol. S. & S. page 470.

The said W. J. Shackton died intestate about twenty years ago, leaving as his sole heirs at law, his four children the said W. J. Shackton, Henry W. Shackton, Mrs. Annie T. Woodlett and Miss Emmie R. Shackton.
