

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That We, Robert Littlejohn and Anna Littlejohn of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, We the said Robert Littlejohn and Anna Littlejohn in and by our certain note or obligation bearing the 7th day of January 1922

We are indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Four Hundred fifty & 29/100 (\$450.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum payable monthly, from the 7th day of January A. D. 1922,

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that we the said Robert Littlejohn & Anna Littlejohn shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, of Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of January 1922,

and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Seven & 29/100 (\$7.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Forty and 29/100 Shares of Stock, and Three & 29/100 (\$3.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Six & 9/100 (\$6.90) Dollars, (\$4.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three & 29/100 (\$3.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of Six & 37/100 (\$6.30) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One & 8/100 (\$1.80) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five & 7/100 (\$5.70) Dollars,

(\$4.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and One & 27/100 (\$1.20) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five & 17/100 (\$5.10) Dollars, (\$4.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and Sixty cents (\$0.60) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 4 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by to be credited as payment upon the advance or loan made we the said

Robert Littlejohn and Anna Littlejohn and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon or charged against us the said Robert Littlejohn and Anna Littlejohn in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said Robert Littlejohn & Anna Littlejohn in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to us the said Robert Littlejohn and Anna Littlejohn in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the city of Greenville, 1st ward Five and being heretofore designated on plat recorded in R. M. C. office for said County in Plat Book "A" at page 403, (reference to which is hereby waived for a full description) as lot No. one (1) fronting on Bower street and being the same lot conveyed to us by Hattie Tansill by deed dated December 2nd 1921, and recorded in volume 72 page 317, R. M. C. office for Greenville County and being the same lot conveyed to the said Hattie Tansill by D. W. Moore by deed dated March 13th 1920 and recorded in said R. M. C. office in vol. #63 at page 426.
