WHEREAS, M.C. Bishop, the said M.C. Bishop, in and by me, certain note or obligation, bearing the 2nd day of May, 1925

duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Twelve Hundred & 00/100 (\$1200.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 2nd day of May, A. D. 1925,

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I, the said M.C. Bishop, shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of May, 1925,

and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months the sum of Twenty & 00/100 (\$20.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the Twelve (12) Shares of Stock, and Eight & 00/100 (\$8.00) Dollars,

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eighteen & 40/100 (\$18.40) Dollars,

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock, and Six & 40/100 (\$6.40) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Sixteen & 80/100 (\$16.80) Dollars,

( \$12.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock, and Four & 80/100 (\$4.80) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Fifteen & 20/100 (\$15.20) Dollars,

( \$13.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Three & 20/100 (\$3.20) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Thirteen & 60/100 (\$13.60) Dollars,

( \$12.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and One & 00/100 (\$1.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Twelve (12) shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by M.C. Bishop, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

Bishop, in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Oak Street and running thence 43 feet along said Oak Street to an open pier thence along line of Mills Manufacturing Company 65.8 feet to a point adjoining lots No. 1 and 2 thence along line of Lot No. 2 to a point 173.5 feet more or less thence to the beginning point on Oak Street 65.8 feet and being the rear portion of Lot No. 1 in Block L. referred to in Plat Book W. at page 157 and being the same lot conveyed to me by W.S.
