

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, E. R. Phillips, Jr. of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said E. R. Phillips, Jr. in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the 24th day of August 1925

I am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Three Thousand + 40/100 (\$3000.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 24th day of August A. D. 1925, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said E. R. Phillips, Jr. shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of September 1925, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for fourty successive months, the sum of \$35.00

Dollars, (\$15.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the 30 Shares of Stock, and \$20.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid fourty monthly payments, and shall for the next fourty months pay the sum of \$31.00 Dollars, (\$15.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock, and \$16.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

and the balance of the principal and interest on this note is due for the next twenty months the sum of \$35.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$16.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$35.00 Dollars, (\$15.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$20.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$35.00 Dollars, (\$15.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$20.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 30 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount of such time paid shares by I to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made to the said E. R. Phillips, Jr. and shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes which may be duly imposed upon or charged against I the said E. R. Phillips, Jr. in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition hereunto written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said E. R. Phillips, Jr. in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said E. R. Phillips, Jr. in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all the tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:
