Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 2.20 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$1.47 Dollars, (5.50

Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 5/12 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$2.23 Dollars, (5.50
