Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second
part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the Park Road, near the Spartanburg Road, and being known as Lot No. 1 on a plat made by C.M. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book E., page 159, being a portion of Lot No. 3 on said last mentioned plat, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on Park Road, corner of 20 foot alley, and running thence with Park Road S. 24.05 E. 50 feet to stake; thence N. 74.50 E. 183.22 feet to stake; thence N. 24.05 W. 50 feet to stake on 20 foot alley; thence with said Alley S. 74.50 W. 183.4 feet to beginning corner.
