the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate in Ward Four of the City of Greenville, on the South side of Webster Street, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron at a rock wall at the corner of Nathan Hatcher's lot; thence running E. along said Webster Street 50 feet and 11 inches to a fence; thence South along said fence 102 feet and 3 inches to dividing fence between lot belonging to Tandy Wooten, bought from Butler and McCullough; thence along said fence 51 feet to a fence dividing the property of Nathan Hatcher and this property; thence North along said fence 101 feet and 6 inches to the beginning corner, containing 5151 Sq. Ft. more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Thomas J. Neal this day.
