On the 1st day of December 1941,

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Jessie L. Richardson being the owner of the above mentioned property, in and by me certain, for necessary and sufficient consideration paid me on the 1st day of December 1941, well and truly indebted to me, in the full and just sum of \$2,000.00, Dollars, to be paid three years after date of this note, and cancellation of same, with interest thereon, from the date of this note at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee,

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (also which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear).

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Jessie L. Richardson, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said,

in hand well and truly paid by the said Jessie L. Richardson,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. A. Henderson, his heirs and assigns,

all that certain piece parcel and lot of land situated lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid and situated on the north side of Richardson Street in the town of Simpsonville facing along said Street 80 feet and receding back 170 ft. bounded by lands of L. L. Richardson on the east, G. W. Brooks on the north and myself on the west and being a portion of the land conveyed to me by J. P. W. C. Copeland by deed dated Jan. 8th, 1919 and recorded in the Office of C. M. Mr. of Greenville County in vol. 16 at page 229 being more fully said deed there appearing in the name of my husband, Mrs. L. L. Richardson.
