All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate on the west side of Rowley Street in the City and County of Greenville and State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Rowley Street, corner of lot of J. B. Jones and running thence N. 69-29 W. 310 feet with Jones line to a stake on an alley; thence with the said alley S. 20-19 W. 78 1/2 feet to a stake on the old Cleveland-Stone line; thence S. 75-36 E 210 feet (Approximately) to a stake on Rowley Street; thence with said Street N. 20-19 E. 55 feet to the point of beginning.
