WHEREAS, we, the said The First Baptist Church of Mountain Inn, S.C. in and by our certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

Wm. Chamberlain in the sum of Five Thousand and no<sup>o</sup> 100 Dollars, to be paid three years after date of this note, with privilege of prepaying at any interest period. Paid interest period to be Dec. 31st annually so it shall have effect.

with interest thereon, from the date until paid off at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent.

Besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof we, by acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Wm. Chamberlain his heirs and assigns

All that certain piece of land lying being and situate in the town of Mountain Inn, Beaufort County and State of aforesaid, (the east side of Weston Street); Beginning at the corner on corner of Weston and Hellams Streets running thence N. 52° E. 310 feet; thence S. 38° E. 130 feet thence E. 85° W. 310 feet to Weston Street thence along said Street N. 38° W. 310 feet to the beginning appearing in the plans of the town of Mountain Inn, lot no 61, according to a survey made by J. R. Hellams in 1885 and conveyed to the First Baptist Church by Evaline S. Maroney.

This obligation is made pursuant to the authority given in a resolution passed by the congregation of the First Baptist Church of Mountain Inn, S.C. at a meeting duly assembled on the 6th day of July A.D. 1925 which said resolution is certified to by the moderator and Clerk of said church attached, and made a part hereof.
