Mrs. Calie M. Babt, in the full and just sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000.00) Dollars, to be paid one year after date.

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Calie M. Babt, her heirs and

assigns, all that lot of land situate in the State and County of said in Greenville Township, designated as lot No. 33 of the Overbrook Subdivision as shown by Plat of Overbrook Land Company recorded in Plat Book "E", page 251, R. M. C. Office for said County, having the following lines and bounds to wit: - Beginning at a joint on the old Spartanburg Road (North Street Extension) at joint corner of lots 32 and 33 of said subdivision and running thence along south side of said road N. 69-15 E. 80 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 33 and 34, thence S. 35-30 E. 195.2 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in line of lot No. 37, thence S. 64-59 W. 64 feet to an iron pin, joint corners of lots 32 and 33, thence N. 39-45 W. 194.7 feet to an iron pin on the south side of the old Spartanburg Road, the point of beginning.
