SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said E. L. Glass, in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Thaxter Wilson, a volunteer fireman, for an amount of \$125.00, in the full and just sum of Thirteen Hundred and Fifty (\$125.00) Dollars, to be paid Thirtynine days from date

with interest thereon, from June 1926, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$25.00

to Thaxter Wilson, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thaxter Wilson, a volunteer fireman,

all and every certain piece, bounded on lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward One, of the city of Greenville, on the South side of Craft Street beginning at a stake on the South side of said Street and running thence S. 63° 35' W. 187 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 83° 25' W. 13 feet to a stake thence S. 63° 35' W. 28 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 83° 25' W. 48.7 feet to a stake, thence N. 63° 35' E. 215.7 feet to a stake, thence with said Craft Street S. 83° 25' E. 50 feet to the beginning corner and being Lot No. one (1) of a Plat made by C.
