SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *George Owens*, in and by my certain Predecessor, in writing, or even date with these presents, *Sept. 25th, 1925*, well and truly indebted to

J. K. Earle, in the full and just sum of *Fifteen Hundred Fifty-nine + 26/100 (\$1559.26)* Dollars, to be paid five (5) years after date, with privilege to pay the whole amount at any time, or as much as Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars for any time before maturity

with interest thereon from *September 25th, 1925* at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *September 25th, 1925*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent. (10%)*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant, bargain, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. K. Earle* his heirs and assigns

All that ~~preceding~~ parcel or lot of land in Gant Township, County of Greenville, State of aforesaid, about five and one-half miles East of Greenville Court House on the South side of the White Horse Road and being Tract No. 2 of the lands of *J. K. Earle*, containing ten (10) acres more or less, and having the following metes and bounds as shown by plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, August 1916.

Beginning at a pin in the center of the White Horse Road and running thence with line of Batson property S. 4-30 W. 992.6 feet to a stone on McWhite property; thence with line of McWhite's land S. 64-10 E. 3 ft. feet to iron pin corner of Tract No. 3; thence with line of Tract No. 3, N. 12-15 E. 1044.9 feet to White Horse Road; thence with said White Horse Road N. 74-30 W. 500 feet to the beginning corner and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by *J.
