computed and paid **semi-annually**

interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same is placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, refer-
ence being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said **Norwood National Bank: All my right, title and interest, the**

same being an undivided one-half interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side of Prentiss Avenue, outside the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of Block "L" of the O.P. Mills property, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book "C", page 176, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on Prentiss Avenue, corner of Lot No. 2 of Block "L"; and running thence with Prentiss Avenue N. 45-27 E. 63 feet to iron pipe, corner of lot No. 4; thence with line of lot No. 4, S. 44-33 E. 180 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S. 45-27 W. 63 ft. to an iron pipe, corner of lot- No. 2; thence with line of Lot No. 2, N. 44-33 W. 180 ft. to the beginning corner.

Also all my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-fourth interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Greenville Township, on the corner of Woodside Avenue and the Old Pendleton or Pickens Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of the said Woodside Avenue and old Pendleton Road, and running thence with Woodside Avenue 30 ft. more or less, to corner of lot now or formerly owned by A.C. Batson thence with his line 50 ft. to corner of lot of A.C. Batson and E.E. Stone; thence with E.E. Stone's line toward the Old Pendleton Road 24 ft. to corner; thence in a straight line to the beginning corner.

Also all my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-fourth interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, in the Town of West Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake at turn of Pendleton Road near the underpass of the Southern Railway Company; thence in an easterly direction with said Pendleton Road 1 foot to corner of lot owned by Manos Brothers, Inc., et al.; thence with line of said last mentioned lot in a northerly direction 24-1/2 ft. to stake; thence in a line parallel with Pendleton Road in a westerly direction 5 ft., more or less, to stake on said Pendleton Road; thence with said Pendleton Road in a southerly direction about 25 ft. to the beginning corner.
