interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%.

bargain, sell and release unto the said The Woodside National Bank,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville  
Township, Greenville, County State of South Carolina  
and having the following metes and bounds:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Parker Street; thence  
S. 12-3/4 E. 1/13 feet with Parker Street to an iron pin  
thence N. 82-1/4 E. 160 feet to an iron pin; thence N.  
13 E. 92-2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 88-3 W. 206  
feet to beginning corner, being lots 5 and 6 as  
shown on a plat surveyed by W. A. Hudson, March  
8, 1904, being the same conveyed to P. D. Sutton by F. F.  
Laywers, by deed dated July - 1905, recorded in Book  
000, page 410. Also that other lot of land in  
the Township, County and State aforesaid near  
the City of Greenville, in subdivision of the Morgan  
Hill Addition, and having the following metes
