beginning at iron pin on Stanton Bridge Road at
the corner of lands of St. Frank Smith running thence N.

iron pin; thence S. 35-04 E. 937 ft. to iron stake in the Stanton
Bridge Road; thence with said road N. 64-38 E. 600 ft. 7 in.
