WHEREAS, I, the said *Minnie E. Cooper*, in and by my certain Promissory Note, in writing, or even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to A. L. Bruce,

in the full and just sum of Three Thousand Dollars, to be paid as stated Cheshire, State of South Carolina, on

with interest thereon, from Date, annually, until paid in full; the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear).

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That, the said *Minnie E. Cooper*,

in consideration of the sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *A. L. Bruce*,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *Minnie E. Cooper*,

in hand well and truly paid by the said *A. L. Bruce*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *A. L. Bruce*, all that piece, part

of tract of land lying and being in the State, and County aforesaid, on Clear Creek, Waters of Youth, Sycamore River and having the following miles and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stone 38, Johnson's corner, and running thence N. 6.5° to an Iron Pin, thence N. 44½, E. 17.75 to an Iron Pin, thence N. 10° E. 16.75 thence to an Iron Pin on Clear Creek, thence down the meanders of the said creek to the mouth of a branch of thence, up the meanders of the branch about 3.80 chs to a stone, thence S. 4½ E. 14.20 chs to a stone on old line, thence S. 87.94 W. 28.08 chs to the beginning corner and containing 41.38 acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by H. M. Yarrow, by deed dated November 9, 1925.
