All that certain piece, percel or tract of land, situated, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, in Ward Four (4) and on the north side of Lois Street of said City, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Lois Street (originally Ars. Cooksey's corner), and running thence in an easternly direction along said Street fifty seven (57) feet to an iron pin (orginally F.M.Langley corner); thence with Langley line in a morthernly direction one hundred and eight feet to a fence on lin of the Ferrell lot; thence with line of the Ferrell and Earle lots in a westernly direction, fifty five (55) feet to Ars.
