Howard beginning at a corner on road with Garrett property and runs thence S. 87 E. 24.50 to Iron pin thence S. 66 E. 3.75 to stone thence S. 47 E. 8.35 to stone thence S. 47 1/2 W. 11.80 to stone thence N. 61 3/4 W. 29.70 to stone on road, thence along said road N. 20 E. 5.17 to the beginning corner and being the same lands this day conveyed to Mary K. Tempelton by W. H. Howard, by deed to be recorded, also all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land in Greenville Township and State of South Carolina and in the City of Greenville, in a subdivision of property known as East Park, shown on plat made by W.
