SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said *W. F. Gaylord*, in and by my certain Promissory note..... in writing, of even date with these presents, *Aug.* well and truly indebted to *People's Bank of Ft. Inv. S.C. A Corporation!* in the full and just sum of *Four Thousand three hundred Twenty Sixty Eight Dollars*, to be paid *1st. 1st 1926*

with interest thereon, from *Maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Judge Clark*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note..... to be collectible as a part thereof, to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage, as is and by the said note..... reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at hand well and truly paid by the said *People's Bank of Ft. Inv. S.C. A Corporation* at and before the signing of these Presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said *People's Bank of Ft. Inv. S.C. A Corporation* its successors and assigns,

all my right, title, and interest, of, in and to all that within piece parcel or tract of land in County and state aforesaid, containing 112 acres more or less and being the same land described to John F. Gaylord by deed of from H. P. Werner Miller April 5, 1889 and recorded in the office R. M. C. of Greenville County in deed book 76 at page 9, reference thereto being made for a full description thereof. My interest in said lands having been acquired by inheritance and by deed from other heirs of John F. Gaylord. My present interest therein being one-half undivided interest, this mortgage being given to settle some the payment of a four thousand dollar note and mortgage now held by the People's Bank of Franklin, N. H. The consideration for this obligation is the agreement of the People's Bank of Ft. Inv. to extend the time of payment of what other obligations.
