That I, Elliott Butler of Greenville County, South Carolina SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Elliott Butler
in and by W certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, an well and truly indebted to

W. T. Hudson
in the full and just sum of Two hundred forty-one and 1200/100 (\$241.12)
Dollars, to be paid one (1) year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder
hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said
debt, or) any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said
note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I the said Elliott Butler
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said
W. T. Hudson

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
Elliott Butler

in hand well and truly paid by the said
W. T. Hudson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents,
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. T. Hudson, his heirs and assigns, all my right, title and

interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, being about two and one-half miles west of Greenville Court House and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of a ten foot alley at Sally Brown's corner and running thence with said alley S. 81-3/4 E. 142 feet to a stone 3x0n; thence N. 14 W. 16-1/2 feet with line of lot conveyed to Robert Scott to a stake; thence N. 81-3/4 W. 142 feet to iron pin in Sally Browns line; thence with her line S. 14 E. to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to Emma Butler by Victoria Scott Carter et al. by deed dated June 4, 1910, Emma Butler having died intestate leaving me as her surviving husband and certain children.
