All of that *particular* parcel and lot of land situate, lying and
being in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina and
more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at a point at the intersection of E. North
Street and the Laurens Road on the west side of Richland
Creek and running thence in a southwesterly direction along
the south-east side of said North Street 20 ft. to the H. B.
Stiffin property; thence along the line of said property and
