WHEREAS, I, the said C.M. Harling, in and by certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Twenty seven hundred fifty (\$2750.00) Dollars, to be paid sixty (60) days after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid monthly in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under the mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel, or part of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 7 as shown on plat recorded in the office of the S.M.C. for Greenville County in plat book "E" at page 240, said plat having been prepared by C.M. Furman, Jr. C.E. April 15th, 1920, said lot being on the north side of West Washington Street in the City of Greenville. Beginning at a point of West Washington, joint corner of lots No. 7 and 8, running thence north line of lot No. 8, N. 41.40 E 75 feet to a ten foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 48.50 E 18 feet to corner of lot No. 6; thence north line of lot No. 6, S. 41.40 W 95 feet to Washington Street; thence with said Street N. 48.50 W. 18 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same lot of land conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Jerry Burns yet unrecorded.
