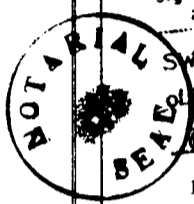

Harling's estate, lying and being in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, near the corner of Spruill Road and the east side of Underwood Ave., being known and designated as lot no. 37 of "Glenn Cross Park" as shown by a subdivision and plat of same, made by R. E.
